During the Week - a drop box is located on the exterior of the building, or in-house during office hours.

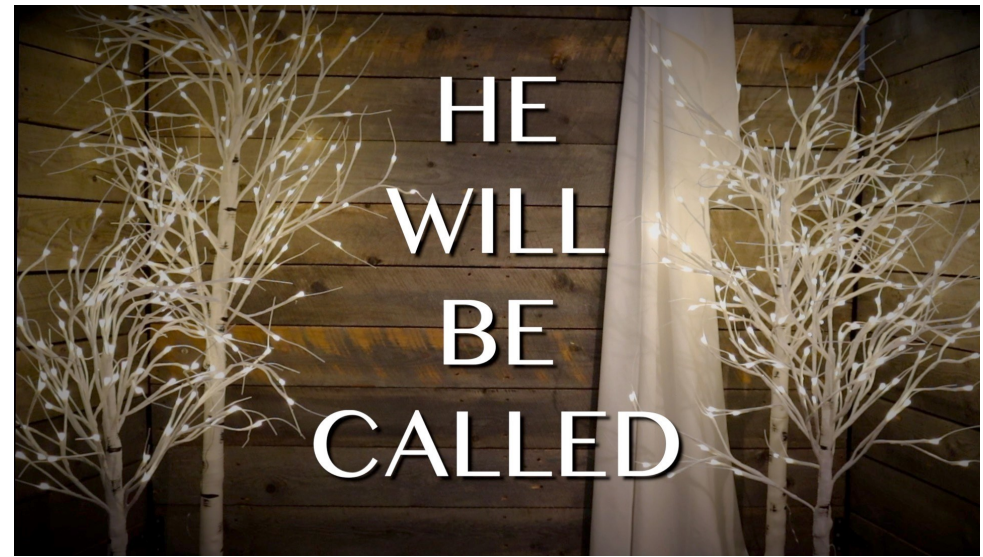

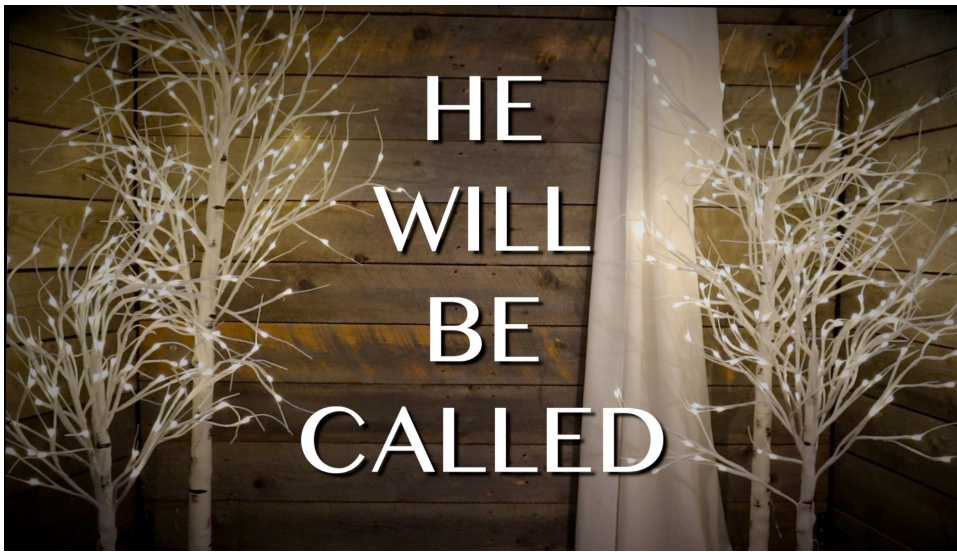

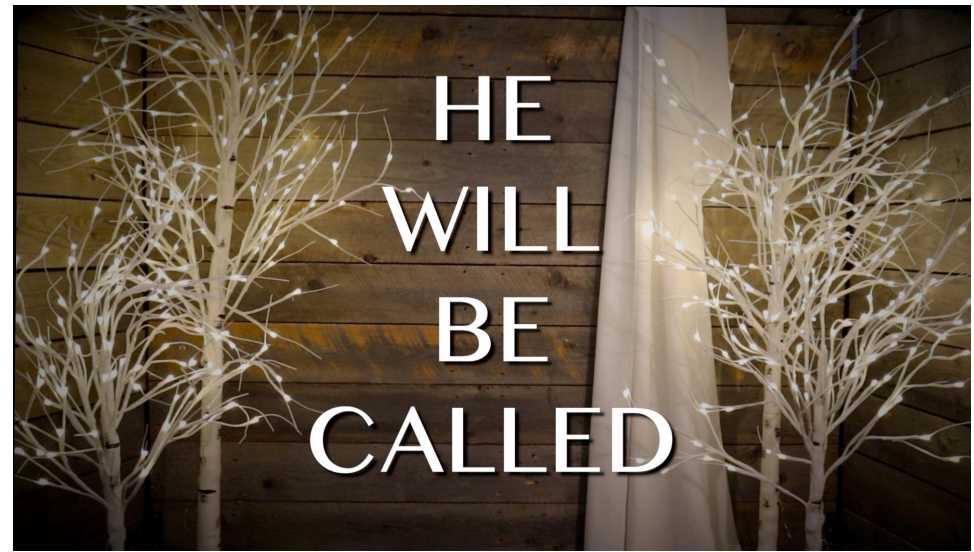
