5. Over what will I proclaim that apart from God it couldn't have existed?
6. How do I want this day to draw me closer to God?
7. How will I live this next week in the grace and faithfulness of God?



Questions for Sermon Based Small Groups

Sabbath Worship

1. Read Genesis 2:1-3. Where can you find reference to the words stop, rest, delight and worship?
2. What is the significance of God calling the Sabbath Day holy? What does it mean to be holy?
3. What is a definition for worship? What does worship encompass?
4. Read Colossians 3:23-24. What does this tell you about what worship can and should look like?
5. What is it about a church service that can help us in our worship?
6. Malcolm Gladwell talks about practicing something for 10000 hours can help you have mastery in that area. Tim compared this to our practice of worshiping God. Was that a fair comparison? What works and what doesn't work with that comparison?
7. Is it really important that we practice worshiping God? Why or why not? Is worshiping God really that difficult?
8. What has been the most significant thing to you in the last four weeks as we have talked about Sabbath?
9. How are you going to change your life/schedule to incorporate more Sabbath into it?
